



Dr. Andrea Salmon is an adult epileptologist with the Calgary Comprehensive Epilepsy Program at Foothills Medical Centre, and a Clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of Clinical Neurosciences for the Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary. Dr. Salmon completed her undergraduate degree in neuroscience at the University of Lethbridge and medical school at the University of Alberta. She completed her neurology training at Western University in London, Ontario followed by a clinical fellowship in epilepsy and EEG at the same institution.
